**Eligibility:**

- 1.** To be eligible, your video must be no longer than 5 minutes in length.
- 2.** Each contestant may only enter one original video, either alone or as part of a team effort.
- 3.** Each contestant must certify on the Entry Form, that the video submission is an original work by the contestant or his/her team and must grant the WSIB unrestricted use and reproduction rights for any purposes.
- 4.** Except for WSIB employees and their immediate family members, this contest is open to all high school students residing in Ontario.
- 5.** Your video must be entirely your (or in the case of a team effort, your teams) own original creation. It must not infringe upon or violate any laws or any third party rights, including, but not limited to, copyright, patent, trademark, trade secret or other proprietary rights and must not lead to any cause of action including libel, defamation, privacy violation, contract breach or tort. Contestants must obtain all necessary permissions, licenses, clearances, releases, waivers of moral rights and other approvals from third parties (including but not limited to all copyright holders and all individuals appearing in the video submission), necessary to use the video submission, in whole or in part, in any way, including without limitation, to reproduce, make derivatives, edit, modify, translate, distribute, transmit, publish, license and broadcast the video submission worldwide, by any means. Any and all such permissions, licenses, clearances, releases, waivers of moral rights and approvals must be attached with your video entry.
- 6.** The video entry must be clearly labeled with your video title, your name, your school's name, mailing address and telephone number. Where more than one student has been involved in the creation of the video, the video entry must be clearly labeled as a team effort.
- 7.** Include your completed Official Entry Form (page 1 and page 2 if required for team information) with your video submission. For the purpose of these Rules, each properly labeled video submission accompanied by a properly completed Official Entry Form shall be considered a valid entry.
- 8.** If any copyright or permissions, licenses, clearances, releases, waivers of moral rights and approvals were obtained, please enclose these with your video entry.

**General Information:**

- 9. Your own personal safety and the safety of your cast, crew and others involved with the production of the video submission must be maintained. Do not endanger anyone during the making of your video. If you are on a work site, take all appropriate health and safety precautions including without limitation following all applicable health and safety policies and regulations. You may wish to consult with a supervisor or other competent individual at the site to obtain this information.**
- 10.** No entries will be returned. All winning entries become the sole property of the WSIB.
- 11.** Three prizes will be awarded in this contest. A prize of two thousand dollars (\$2,000) Canadian will be awarded to the first place entry. A prize of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) Canadian will be awarded to the second place entry. A prize of one thousand two hundred dollars (\$1,200) Canadian will be awarded to the third place entry. Matching prizes are awarded to the high schools of the winning entries.

- 12.** Before collecting a prize, each individual or team member involved in the creation of a winning entry, and, in the case of those individuals or team members who have not yet reached the age of majority, his/her parent or legal guardian will be required to sign a standard declaration and release form confirming compliance with the contest rules, and acceptance of the prize as awarded and assigning all rights, titles and interests in the entry to the WSIB (including a waiver of moral rights) within seven (7) days of being notified that his/her entry has been selected.
- 13.** If a contestant is not 18 years old, the WSIB will require his or her parents or legal guardians authorization before permitting the contestant to participate in the contest and accept a prize as awarded. In the case of a team effort, each member of the team who is not 18 years old must also obtain parental or guardian consent.
- 14.** When entering this contest, each contestant (and where appropriate, with the consent of a parent or guardian) must consent to the use, reproduction, publication, transmission and/or broadcasting of his/her name, address, likeness, school, age, grade and/or prize information, without compensation, in any WSIB advertisement, publication or promotion, for general news or other information purposes. Winners must also consent to their photographs being taken by the WSIB for the same purposes, without further compensation. Each contestant (and where required, his/her parent or guardian) irrevocably and in perpetuity grants the WSIB, without compensation, the right to use the video submission, in whole or in part, in any way, including without limitation, to reproduce, make derivatives, edit, modify, translate, distribute, transmit, publish, license and broadcast the video submission worldwide, by any means.
- 15.** The chances of winning a prize depend on the total number and quality of eligible entries received prior to the closing date.
- 16.** The WSIB reserves the right to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the contest for any reason, without any prior notice to any contestant.
- 17.** These rules may be changed without notice or reason including, if necessary, to comply with any applicable law. By entering this contest, contestants agree to abide by these rules and acknowledge that the WSIB shall not be responsible for any damages, costs, demands, claims or losses of any kind, incurred by any contestant as a result of participation in the Workplace Safety & Insurance Boards Student Video Contest.
- 18.** This contest shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Province of Ontario and any applicable federal laws. These rules govern all aspects of the contest and are binding on all contestants and all other participants including parents, legal guardians and team members, who sign the Official Entry Form.

**Selection of Awards:**

- 19.** Entries will be judged by a panel of judges chosen by the WSIB. The decisions of the judges on all matters relating to the contest are final and not open to dispute.
- 20.** In the case of a team effort, the WSIB may issue pro-rated cheque(s) to each team member. Each winning high school will receive a matching prize equal to the total prize awarded to the team.
- 21.** Each individual or team member who submitted a winning entry will be notified by telephone or email that his/her entry has won and the procedure to follow to claim the applicable prize. If an individual or one or more team members decline the prize, the prize may be forfeited and awarded to another entry in accordance with these contest rules. Only the winning entries will be notified. A list of winning videos will be posted on the prevent-it.ca and wsib.on.ca web sites.

- 22.** If the WSIB does not receive entries of sufficient quantity or quality, the WSIB reserves the right not to award any prizes.

**Entry Information:**

- 23.** Each video must be submitted in either VHS or DVD-R format, one video per VHS or DVD. Multiple videos on one VHS or DVD will not be accepted. Entry form must accompany the video and the video must be clearly labelled (see eligibility section).

- 24.** Your video submission must be received by the WSIB by 4:00 pm on Thursday, April 1, 2010.
